"Truth: Our Sword of Shannara"

As I have been reading Terry Brooks books that began with the "Shannara Chronicles" and continued with saga after saga thereafter; it has been amazing to see the parallels between the work of the Sword of Shannara and the work of the Spirit as it utilizes the word of truth for us as followers of Jesus.
