Seeds are Not Enough

This morning as I was leaving the house I happen to look over at the Tomato and Herb plants that I planted several weeks ago. They have been thriving sense being planted, however, this morning I noticed they where looking a little wilted. Obviously, I'll need to water them this evening and or tomorrow morning.

Throughout the years I have been guilty of preparing soil and planting seeds and then expect "Mother Nature" to do her job and provide me with some sort of beautiful flower or tasty produce. Experience has taught us over the years that just planting the seeds or "plant slips" is not enough. Our part also must include providing water, plant food, positioning the plant in the right place, pulling weeds, and protecting against pests of all sorts.

This is true in discipleship as well. For someone to grow to full maturity within the body of Christ it requires seeds of truth to be planted in their heart and head. Their hearts will need to be nurtured by the love and care of fellow believers. They will need to be positioned in right places for ministry and mission involvement. They will need guidance in getting rid of the "weeds" of their life that would rob them of life that Christ has for them. They will need protection from those that would falsely accuse or deceive them with false teachings.

That is why in Ephesians 4 Paul in speaking of the Body of Christ's function of bringing its people into full maturity says that He; God, has given us Pastors, Teachers, Prophets, Apostles, and Evangelists.

Two invitations, that are actually challenges, I want to make in relationship to these realities.

First—are you being exposed to all that God has provided for you in order for you to grow into full maturity? Who are the pastors, teachers, evangelists, apostles, and prophets that have access to you in order to provide the grace from God that you desperately need? Often, we will only seek out those that we value and limit exposure to those we don't value or understand. If you are not sure what I mean by this; then we need to expose you to some teaching in this arena. Contact me if this is the case for you.

Secondly-Do you know your gifting in one of these areas (Apostle, Prophet, Evangelist, Teacher or Pastor) and if so, how are you offering up this gifting to those around you? Again, if you need guidance or teaching in this area contact me.
