**The Pathway to Thanksgiving**

Jane's and my hearts have become so full of gratitude for all the expressions of love towards us and our family over the last few weeks as we have journeyed and continue to journey through this difficult season. The story of the first Thanksgiving from our heritage is all about the Pilgrims who have come through such difficulty and heartache and their response is to invite the Native Americans to join them in a feast of Thanksgiving. Amazing, in that their response is thanksgiving and not resentment and discouragement. Could it be that it is the expression of Thanksgiving that encouraged their hearts in such a way that it gave them the capacity to continue to face and overcome the difficulties that lie ahead.

The book of Ezra is about the people of Israel who have endured difficulty and deportation to a foreign land finally gaining their freedom to return home to Jerusalem and Judea. In Chapter 3 we find that they come together and begin the process of reestablishing the worship practices in Jerusalem and lay the foundation for the rebuilding of the Temple. As they celebrate the laying of the foundation a spontaneous eruption of praise becomes the response of the people. It is so loud, that it can be heard far away. This eruption of praise and thanksgiving is indicative of hearts that have been traveled a pathway of worship that results in such amazing celebration.

I believe their response can be ours in this season of Thanksgiving, and quite possibly every season. What if we could be those who embody the edification of Paul as he writes in Philippians "Rejoice in all things, and again I say Rejoice." Notice he did not say for all things but in all things. What would happen in our homes, in our congregations, and in our communities if we become those who are continuously living in a spirit of Thanksgiving.

I look forward to discovering what God has for us as we journey through Ezra chapter 3 and discover the pathway to thanksgiving. My prayer is that this journey will do for us what it did for them and prepare us to be a people who have hearts that are so full of an awareness of God's love that they continuously are on the brink of erupting in praise.

# PRESCHOOL NEWS

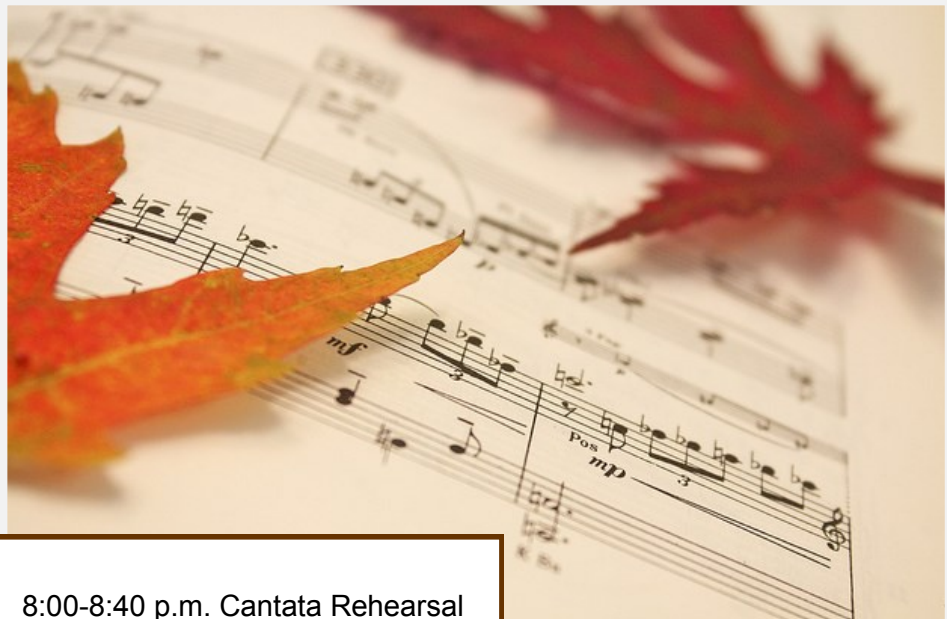
The leaves are falling, the scent of wood burning fires is in the air, frosty mornings, the holidays are not far off!
