The Lesson of the Big Green Chalk Board

For years a Big Green Chalk Board took up residence in the home where I was raised. It first appeared the spring before my oldest brother started school and it kept its place in the living room for over a decade. It held a special place in my heart, because it was at this Big Green Chalk Board that I first learned to write my "ABC's" and spell basic words like cat and hat. My brother began school a year before I did. I could not wait to be able to join him, because he made it sound so fun as he would come home and talk of the friends he made, recess, and games. My Mother knew, however, that school would be more than fun and games and she wanted to get me ready.

The January before I joined my brother at Woodberry Hills Elementary School, my mother would join me at the chalk board to teach me the alphabet and introduce me to the world of spelling. She understood that the season of waiting is the season of preparation. She would apply this life lesson in so many arenas; whether it would be going on vacation or the celebration of Christmas. Mom always had a way of using the season of anticipation and waiting as a time for preparation. We would spend our days leading up to vacation gathering items to be placed in the vacation party box. This box would hold all the fun things we would take with us for the beach or lake; in it you could find swimming masks, decks of cards, small games, beach toys, and the like. To this day I remember all of the fun crafts my mother would have us do as we would use our craft projects to decorate the house for Christmas. And with each project there would be a lesson about the meaning of Christmas.

Looking back, it seems at times that the times of preparation were more special than the event for which we were preparing. The lesson of the Big Green Chalk Board is especially needed in this season. We are in a season of waiting and anticipation; however, it is not a season for doing nothing but waiting. This is to be a season of preparation. I recently read a post from my first cousin that reminded me that as we get prepared to return to life as we knew it, that we need to consider the things that are not worth returning to. As we move forward in this journey of "new normal" let me encourage each of us to learn the lesson my mother taught her family long ago: that the season of waiting can be the most treasured and valuable season of all.
