Over the last few days, I have found myself reflecting on the memories of my Father; that seem so distant now. In this season of remembering I found myself lingering on what I consider one of the greatest gifts my Father gave me. My Father did not evaluate my success based on the fruit of my efforts, but on the intensity of the effort itself. His question in most if not all situations was, "did you give your all."

There were times I would win a wrestling match, or a mile race and have to face a look of disappointment because, he knew that I did not give my best effort even in the victory. There were times after a loss, I would be met with, "way to go son" because in the losing I had given my all. This was true in all arenas of my life even academics.
