
- ⇒ Karen Whitlock shared a draft of the September 29 Family Sunday Worship Service.







- 1. Click on Pack Online
- 2. Click Search for a Goal Page
- 3. Type in Floyd Baptist Church
- 4. Choose the 2024 page at the top of the list.
- 5. Click Build a Shoebox online

The cost is \$25. You can choose the items for the box, or you can choose Build It for Me to let Samaritans Purse choose the items.

If any of you don't have access to a computer or do not want to do this yourself, I (Judy Britt) will be happy to do it for you if you will give me the \$25. I will give you a confirmation that it has been done in your name.

Of course, we still need as many of you as possible to build your shoebox the usual way. There are plenty of boxes available at church along with the brochure telling you how to go about it.
